Vineyard Christian School Lifestyle Contract

Vineyard Christian School is a religious, non-profit Christian School and a representative of Vineyard Christian Churches worldwide. We require our staff members to whole-heartedly agree with our Statement of Faith, be born-again Christians, living their lives as Christian role models (*Romans 10:9-10; 1 Timothy 4:12; Luke 6:40*).

Staff members will conduct themselves in a way that will not raise questions regarding their Christian testimonies. A Christian lifestyle should reflect:

- the biblical perspective of integrity and appropriate personal behavior
- demonstrate a teachable spirit
- have an ability to share love for others
- a willingness to live contentedly under authority
- commit to follow the Matthew 18 principle when an issue arises with a fellow staff member or administration

The Statement of Lifestyle expects staff members to maintain a lifestyle based on biblical standards of moral conduct. Moral misconduct, which violates the occupational qualification for staff members to be Christian role models, includes, but is not limited to:

- promiscuity
- homosexual behavior
- use of illicit drugs
- premarital sex
- use of vulgar language
- use or viewing of pornographic material

Vineyard Christian School staff members will maintain a lifestyle based on biblical standards of moral conduct and will live their lives in accordance to the statement of lifestyle. Failure to do so may result in a reprimand or, in some cases, dismissal from employment. It is the goal of Vineyard Christian School that each employee will have a lifestyle where "...in everything, He might have the supremacy." (*Colossians 1:18*).

Condition of Employment

The employee will demonstrate by precept and example the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a Christian role model both in and out of school to pupils and their families and as an example to fellow faculty members in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living (*1 Tim. 4:12; Luke 6:40*). This includes, but is not limited to the refraining from such activities as:

- the use of alcohol that leads to drunkenness
- tobacco
- illicit drugs
- the use of vulgar and profane language.

I have read and fully understand the statement of lifestyle. I will commit to maintaining a lifestyle based on biblical standards of moral conduct and will live my life in accordance to the statement of lifestyle. (*Matthew 5:14*)

If I begin to struggle in any area of my life that violates the statement of lifestyle, I will commit to making the administration aware of my struggles, and will also confess my sins and seek prayer and guidance from the administration or a trusted believer from my church community. (*Proverbs 28:13*)

Social Networking for Staff:

1. Phone – text – email – social networking sites may only be accessed during breaks and lunch and **not** during your prep times. This time is set aside for you as a time for preparation for your class not personal time.
2. There will be no access from school computers for social networking sites. Designated computers will be set aside for research.
3. Social Networking:
 - a. Students may not “be a friend” or a member of a teacher’s social network until they reach the age of 18.
 - b. No pictures of students are allowed on a teacher’s personal website.
 - c. School issues, policies or questions about these may not be posted on personal sites.
 - d. We strongly recommend that you do not include parents as “friends” or members on your personal sites.
 - e. Pictures or language that is considered inappropriate, crude, profane or suggestive may not be posted on your personal site.
 - f. You are responsible for any content on your personal site in reference to the above criteria.
4. Discipline for offenses to these policies:
 - a. 1st offense: A written warning
 - b. 2nd offense: Suspension without pay
 - c. 3rd offense: Possible termination
5. If the nature of the offense is deemed severe, blatant or flagrant, the discipline taken may not follow the normal steps listed above but progress more quickly. An example of this would be discussions or comments about a student, a parent or fellow employee or negative comments about the school or church.
